### FRONT COVER

The Masked Love Bird (*Agapornis personata*) is one of the most beautiful and desired birds. There is just one species of Masked Love Bird and our front cover shows the normal green. There is also a Blue Mutation of the Masked Love Bird.

### BACK COVER

The Peach Face Love Bird (*Agapornis roseicollis*) is probably the most numerous love bird in captivity. It is hardy, prolific, and has more color mutations than any other *Agapornis*. The back cover displays the most common form of the Blue mutation Peach Face Love Bird.
