

FRONT COVER

The Masked Love Bird (Agapornis personata) is one of the most beautiful and desired birds. There is just one species of Masked Love Bird and our front cover shows the normal green. There is also a Blue Mutation of the Masked Love Bird.

BACK COVER

The Peach Face Love Bird (Agapornis roseicollis) is probably the most numerous love bird in captivity. It is hardy, prolific, and has more color mutations than any other Agapornis. The back cover displays the most common form of the Blue mutation Peach Face Love Bird.
